



## Travel Information

The Atlanta CSEC Center is located in the Gateway Center complex, one stop from Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport on the free, high-speed airport SkyTrain. Visitors and travelers can take the SkyTrain to the airport from the CSEC Center, where public transit into downtown Atlanta is available.

### Travel and Transportation

#### By Air

Atlanta is served by Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport, located approximately 9 miles southwest of the business district via the Southwest Expressway and I-85. The CSEC Center is a 2-minute ride from the airport on the free ATL SkyTrain. From baggage claim, follow signs to the SkyTrain and exit at the first stop, GICC Gateway. Take the elevator down to ground level and follow signs to the Renaissance Atlanta Airport Gateway hotel. The Center is located next to the hotel.

#### By Bus

Greyhound buses drop passengers off on the North side of the entrance to the Atlanta airport. After arriving, follow signs for the SkyTrain. Ride the SkyTrain one stop to the Gateway Center where the CSEC Center is located.

#### By Train

Atlanta is served by Amtrak's Crescent Line, which runs between New Orleans, Louisiana; Atlanta; and New York City. The CSEC center is approximately 25 minutes by taxi from the train station.

### Public Transportation

The Metropolitan Atlanta Rapid Transit Authority (MARTA) provides bus and rail transportation between downtown Atlanta and the metropolitan area. From downtown Atlanta, MARTA trains take approximately 15 minutes to reach the airport and arrive next to the SkyTrain, which provides direct, free transportation to the CSEC Center (follow signs for ground transportation).

MARTA trains arrive and depart from the western end of the terminal complex every 8 minutes. The cost for a one-way bus or train trip is \$2.50. You can purchase a BREEZE card at MARTA's stations and Ride Store inside Airport Station (located inside the western end of the airport's main terminal), from vending machines located in MARTA's rail stations, or at retail outlets in the Atlanta metropolitan area.

## Driving Directions to the CSEC Center

### FROM HARTSFIELD-JACKSON ATLANTA INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

Travel East on North Terminal Parkway. Continue straight to stay on North Terminal Parkway. Keep left at the fork, follow signs for Riverdale Rd/Camp Creek Parkway. Continue onto Camp Creek Parkway. Use the two left lanes to turn left onto S Conley Street/Convention Center Concourse. Turn left onto SkyTrain Way and the CSEC Center will be on the left.

### FROM I-20 EAST OF ATLANTA

Travel West on I-20. Take exit 67A for I-285 South toward Atlanta Airport/Macon. Merge onto I-285 W. Keep left to stay on I-285 W. Use the right 2 lanes to take exit 61 to merge onto I-85 N toward Atlanta. Take exit 72 for Camp Creek Parkway. Continue onto Camp Creek Parkway. Use the left 2 lanes to turn left onto S Conley St/Convention Center Concourse. Turn left onto SkyTrain Way and the CSEC Center will be on the left.

### FROM I-20 WEST OF ATLANTA

Travel East on I-20. Use the right lane to take exit 51A toward I-285 South. Keep right at the fork to continue on Exit 51A, follow signs for I-285 S/Montgomery/Macon and merge onto I-285 South. Take exit 2 for Camp Creek Parkway toward Atlanta Airport. Use the left 2 lanes to turn left onto GA-6 East/Camp Creek Parkway. Turn right onto Airport Drive. Turn left onto Convention Center Concourse. Turn right onto SkyTrain Way and the CSEC Center will be on the left.

### FROM I-75 SOUTH OF ATLANTA

Travel North on I-75. Use the right 2 lanes to take exit 238B to merge onto I-285 West toward the Atlanta Airport. Use the right 2 lanes to take exit 61 to merge onto I-85 North toward Atlanta. Take exit 72 for Camp Creek Parkway. Use the left 2 lanes to turn left onto South Conley Street/Convention Center Concourse. Turn left onto SkyTrain Way and the CSEC Center will be on the left.

### FROM I-85 NORTH OF ATLANTA

Travel South on I-85. Use the right 2 lanes to take exit 72 for Camp Creep Parkway. Keep right to continue on Camp Creek Parkway. Use the left 2 lanes to turn left onto South Conley Street/Convention Center Concourse. Turn left onto SkyTrain Way and the CSEC Center will be on the left.

### FROM I-85 SOUTH OF ATLANTA

Travel North on I-85. Take exit 72 for Camp Creek Parkway. Use the left 2 lanes to turn left onto South Conley Street/Convention Center Concourse. Turn left onto SkyTrain Way and the CSEC Center will be on the left.

## Parking Near the CSEC Center

Parking adjacent to the CSEC Center is very limited and examinees are encouraged to utilize the free ATL SkyTrain from the airport instead (GICC Gateway Center stop). The airport offers Park-Ride lots in both the domestic and international parking lots. Domestic Park-Ride lots cost \$10/day, and the international Park-Ride lot costs \$14/day. All lots have free shuttles to the airport, where one may access the free SkyTrain to the CSEC Center.

## Lodging Near the CSEC Center

The following hotels offer discounts for Step 2 CS examinees, based on availability. Since these discounts may only be available by telephone, it is recommended that you call these establishments to make your reservations. Ask about the discount for individuals taking the Clinical Skills exam at the local testing center, and be sure to mention one or more of the following: USMLE, NBME, CSEC, and ECFMG.
